Minutes of Meeting of the Board of Directors
June 6, 2013**

The Board of Directors of Chisholm Trail Special Utility District of Williamson, Bell, and Burnet Counties, Texas convened in a meeting at the administrative office of Chisholm Trail Special Utility District located at 851 FM 970, Florence Williamson County, Texas beginning at 5:30 p.m. on the 6th day of June, 2013. Notices of the time, place, and subject of the meeting were posted at the places and for the time required by law.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.

Executive Session

- b. Discussion regarding other personnel positions.
