

Chisholm Trail Special Utility District Hosts Customer Meeting

Chisholm Trail Special Utility District provides treated water to over 6,700 customers in Williamson, Bell and Burnet counties. The District and the City of Georgetown authorized a feasibility study to evaluate possible consolidation. The study was received during a public meeting, which was held on June 13, 2012. The feasibility study, questions and answers, from the June 13th meeting, are posted on the District's web site, www.ctsud.org.

The District Board of Directors have scheduled a meeting for Tuesday, August 21, 2012, to receive comments in regard to the future of the District, possible consolidation with the City of Georgetown, and alternative options available to the District. A brief explanation of those options will be presented prior to receiving comments from the public.

Each speaker will be limited to three (3) minutes and yielding of time will not be allowed.

The meeting to receive public comments will be held at the Georgetown Chamber of Commerce, 100 Stadium Drive, Georgetown, Texas, and will begin at 6:00 p.m.
